ten (10) days of the date of this Order, defendants shall produce:


1. By agreement of the parties, in-service materials as ordered in paragraph 6(h) of this Court's July 5, 2011 order, regardless of whether they are maintained in employee personnel files or elsewhere.
2. Notes of an exit interview with Gloria Kirby.
3. Documents from personnel files previously ordered in this Court's July 5, 2011 order, paragraphs 5 and 7 as applicable, for Collin Tierney and Nadine Fresnell.

This motion is denied as to personnel files of Kevin Ross, Katy Brogan and John Frederick, because they were not requested in discovery.

4. Documents related to the termination of the employment of the Director of Nursing in December 2010 but only to the extent that those documents refer to any incident involving the plaintiff or incidents from December 2, 2008 through March 21, 2010, related to the subjects specified in paragraph 6 of this court's July 5, 2011 order.

5. Defendants shall produce the former Director of Nursing to testify only about the reasons for the termination of her employment. Plaintiff may not inquire about the identities of any other resident involved in incidents that led to the termination of the former Director of Nursing's employment. Defendants shall bear the cost of this continued deposition, including the cost of the transcript for both plaintiff and defendants. If plaintiff obtains testimony about this issue from John Frederick, and the former Director of Nursing's testimony would be cumulative, she may not be re-deposed.
