AND NOW, this *6th* day of *Aug*, 2009, upon consideration of the plaintiff's motion to compel discovery, the defendants' response thereto, and the recommendation of the Discovery Master after a discovery conference, it is hereby ORDERED that the motion is GRANTED as follows:

The defendants, upon good cause shown, by August 26, 2009, shall produce documents, including incident reports, responsive to request for production of documents number 6 as to McCarthy and other residents of Chapel Manor from February 23, 2006 through April 9, 2007, for similar incidents. Similar incidents are those involving:

1. Resident falls.
2. Pressure ulcers to buttocks and ankles.
3. Resident wandering.


4. Bruises, skin tears, lacerations.

5. Malfunctioning and/or unused bed and/or chair alarms.

Defendants shall provide the residents' years of birth, but may redact names, dates of birth, room numbers, social security numbers, addresses, and other information as may be statutorily required.

Defendants shall provide a description of information redacted in accordance with statutory requirements, and the plaintiff shall not disclose or disseminate the documents produced except for the purposes of this and related litigation. Plaintiff, after reviewing the documents ordered to be produced and upon further good cause shown, may seek additional documents.
