ORDER

AND NOW, this *30th* day of *July*, 2009, upon consideration of the defendants' motion to compel discovery, the plaintiff's response thereto, and the recommendation of the Discovery Master after a discovery conference, it is hereby ORDERED:

1. Defendants' motion to compel answers to interrogatory numbers 3 through 6 is denied without prejudice. Counsel for all parties are ORDERED to meet and confer about narrowing the issues and parties in this case by July 30, 2009, after the completion of the bulk of discovery. After that meeting, defendants may request consideration of this motion as to the issues remaining in the case.
2. By August 5, 2009, with respect to defendants' interrogatory number 10, plaintiff shall provide, if known or reasonably ascertainable, the names, addresses, and specialties of health care providers of

Ransome, and also the reasons for treatment and approximate dates of care for the period of residency. Plaintiff shall identify Ransome's primary care physicians and provide their names and addresses.

3. The motion is granted as to defendants' interrogatories, set I, number 12. Plaintiff shall respond fully by August 5, 2009.

4. Defendants' motion to compel is granted as to defendants' interrogatories set II, numbers 2 through 6 and request for production of documents numbers 3 through 4 and 11. Plaintiff shall provide answers or authorizations for medical records sought by August 5, 2009.

5. Defendants' motion to compel is granted as to request for production number 14 related to employee contact discovery. Plaintiff shall respond fully by August 5, 2009, and shall produce a privilege log as to all documents as to which plaintiff claims attorney work product.
