ORDER

AND NOW, this ~~19TH~~ day of *May*, 2009, upon consideration of the plaintiff's motion to overrule objections to plaintiff's request for production of documents, set I, and the recommendation of the Discovery Master after a discovery conference, it is hereby ORDERED:

1. With respect to request number 18, by May 22, 2009, defendants shall provide a list of types of documents that exist that are responsive to this request, and plaintiff shall provide a list of types of documents that plaintiff believes may exist that are needed. By May 22, 2009, counsel shall meet and attempt to resolve this issue of what documents shall be produced. If counsel cannot resolve this matter, counsel shall promptly notify the Discovery Master.


2. With respect to request number 28, by June 4, 2009, defendants shall produce the requested documents for three months

prior to and including January 17, 2007. Upon good cause shown after review of those documents, plaintiff may request an additional three prior months of those documents.

3. By June 4, 2009, defendants shall produce the documents requested in number 32.

4. By June 4, 2009, defendants shall produce names and last known addresses or telephone numbers for each person who worked at Centennial Village on the same unit or wing that Lottie Runnells resided from December 9, 2005 until January 17, 2007, as requested in number 34. Plaintiff and plaintiff's counsel may not use, disseminate, or disclose this information, and are required to keep this information confidential, except for legitimate uses for this case. Request number 34 is denied as to the remaining documents requested.
