AND NOW, this 28th day of September, 2010, upon consideration of plaintiff's motion for sanctions directed to defendant Willow Terrace for failure to comply with the Court's July 30, 2010 order, it is hereby ORDERED that plaintiff's motion is GRANTED in part and DENIED in part as follows.


1. By September 30, 2010, defendant Willow Terrace shall produce documents responsive to request number 11 and request number 43 (a) through (c) and (e) through (j) as previously ordered by this Court.
2. The motion is denied as moot as to request number 43(d).
3. Upon good cause shown, by September 30, 2010 Willow Terrace shall produce the following documents responsive to plaintiff's request for production of documents numbers 35-37 and 39-42 for Patricia Haynes, R.N. and Rosemary Fallon, R.N.

- a. Applications for employment
- b. Criminal background checks
- c. Licensing and certification documents
- d. Disciplinary actions
- e. Performance Evaluations
- f. Exit interviews and forms
- g. Resignation letters
- h. Termination Letters

Willow Terrace shall provide a description of information redacted in accordance with statutory requirements, and the plaintiff shall not disclose or disseminate the documents produced except for the purposes of this and related litigation.

4. *If there is continued non-compliance with this Court's*
 Defendant Willow Terrace ~~is~~ *will be* ordered to pay to plaintiff *Order 2*
 \$350.00 in attorneys fees and costs incurred in connection with this *7/30/10!*
 motion. Willow Terrace is cautioned that failure to comply with this
 order may result in the imposition of further sanctions *upon application*
to the Court.
